Terms and Conditions

Meetings

Meetings are held on a monthly basis and may be subject to change around Bank Holidays. Meetings commence promptly at 9.30am unless otherwise agreed by the group agent. The first 30 minutes are for informal networking, followed by a formal welcome and introductions by the agent, a peer presentation and then tables are hosted by peers until the meeting closes two hours after the official start time. Members are encouraged to take part as visitor hosts or to work the registration table and need to arrive fifteen minutes before the official start time to meet and greet visitors. This is an important element of the meeting as it ensures visitors feel comfortable and that new connections can be made.

Company Structure

Pink Link Ladies Ltd is currently developing groups in various geographical locations. Groups are overseen by the Directors and are run in conjunction with the local agent or licence holder for the area.

Membership

There are currently five forms of membership, Peer, Peer Plus, Member, Member Plus and Sponsorship. Each membership entitles an individual to membership of a specific group. The maximum representatives from any company are restricted to two and they would have to purchase individual memberships. You may elect a substitute from within your business to attend in your place, if you cannot attend. You are encouraged to attend in person as this is proven to be more effective. Members can attend other Pink Link Ladies groups as a visitor or they may join as a member at the discretion of the agent, licence holder, but the Directors have the right to the final decision.

- **Peers** Only one lady may join as a peer from any given business sector. Any deviation to this is at the discretion of the Directors and only if seen beneficial for the group members. Peers must be willing to host tables to give advice freely on their subject to members, give presentations on request and submit blogs for the online community.
- **Members** There may be multiple members from any business sector and we encourage our members to work together.

Visitors

All members are encouraged to refer visitors to the group. Visitors may attend twice at any group before deciding to join. Further visits are at the discretion of the agents, licence holder and ultimately the Directors. Visitors to any group must pay an attendance fee which is set for that group. Where a business provides more than one key product or service, the member must focus on what they consider to be their core activity within the group.

Meeting Registration

It is the responsibility of members to register attendance for meetings via the website or eventbrite.com. All members and visitors are requested to register to ensure that meetings are organised effectively.

Fees

Once an application for membership has been approved then membership fees will be due for payment by the invoice date. Failure to pay may result in an application being revoked. In the event of a member wishing to leave the group mid membership no refund of fees will be made. Members will be asked to re-apply for membership at the end of their membership period. Membership is annual.

Website

The Pink Link Ladies website is for members to join and it is your responsibility to keep your information current. Members are responsible for the submission of keywords to the Pink Link Ladies Administrator. Misuse of the chat area will not be permitted and may lead to an online member being terminated.

Disciplinary

In the event of any conflict or complaint this should be made in writing to the local Agent, Licence holder or Directors where appropriate. They will make every effort to resolve the problem and have the authority to suspend membership, terminate membership or issue an official warning. All members are requested to refrain from denigrating any other member or company.
